Instructions for Pesach 5785 | 2025

When Erev Pesach Falls on Shabbos

This year, in addition to all the halachos that go into making Pesach, there is an additional complexity in observance that we aren't as familiar with, since it doesn't occur often (the last time was in 2021). Erev Pesach, which is usually when we are busy doing last minute cleaning, doing a Siyum for the first-born, selling chametz, burning chametz, etc., this year falls out on Shabbos, thus precluding us from all our normal erev Pesach activities. The following document outlines protocols for when Erev Pesach falls on Shabbos:

1. **Shabbos HaGadol:** While technically, the Shabbos before Pesach is called Shabbos HaGadol, it is customary for the Rav to give a drasha with practical information about Hilchos Pesach. If the Rav were to give his drasha the day before Pesach, it would not be of much help, so the custom is for the Shabbos before Shabbos HaGadol to be designated for the Shabbos HaGadol drasha. This will be on the afternoon of Shabbos, April 5.

2. **Fast of the First-Born (Taanis Bechorim):** This fast day is for the first-born males of each family on Erev Pesach, to commemorate the miracle of the Plague of the First-Born. Since we're not permitted to fast on Shabbos, we push this fast to the Thursday prior (not Friday, since we never push a pre-empted fast to Friday so that people don't enter into Shabbos in a state of ravenous hunger). Our minhag is to offer a siyum for the Bechorim, which would allow them to eat. As such, we will be offering the Siyum at each of our daily minyanim on Thursday morning, April 10. Stay tuned for details.

3. **Bedikas and Biur Chametz:** We will search for Chametz on Thursday night, April 10, after 8:41 pm. You DO make a bracha on the bedikah, and will recite the "kol chamira" declaration after your bedikah. If you are setting aside chametz to be consumed on Shabbos, you should put that in a tightly sealed bag or disposable container and segregate it in a specially designated place. When doing Biur Chametz the following morning, even though technically we are permitted to partake of chametz the

entire day, we comport ourselves as if Friday, April 11, is erev Pesach (in order to avoid confusion for future years), and therefore burn the Chametz by the end of the fifth hour, which in Thornhill is 11:48 am. The only difference this year is that after Biur Chametz you will NOT recite the "kol chamira" declaration, and will rather say that on Shabbos morning, as per below.

4. **Sale of Chametz:** Similar to Biur Chametz, the selling of your chametz to a non-Jew will be done as if Friday is erev Pesach. We will thus do the sale on Friday morning before the time of Biur Chametz. Please make sure you have all your Chametz sale forms (download a .pdf version or .docx version) emailed by Thursday afternoon, April 10, at 2 pm at the very latest, to give our office time to print out your form and include in the sale.

5. **Shabbos Meals and Lechem Mishneh:** On Shabbos we are obligated to have one meal with bread (Lechem Mishneh – two loaves) on Friday night, one meal with bread on Shabbos morning, and a third meal (Shalosh Seudos), preferably with bread, on Shabbos afternoon. This presents a challenge this year, since we will already be Pesach-dik, with our houses cleaned and our Pesach utensils already out. We cannot use matzah for our Lechem Mishneh, because it is forbidden halakhically to eat matzah on Erev Pesach. Furthermore, we are not permitted to eat Chametz on Erev Pesach past the fourth hour of the day.

We present two viable solutions:

Option A: Before Shabbos, set aside just the amount of bread that you and your family will need for Lechem Mishneh. Place it in a tightly sealed bag or disposable container in a designated place. When it's time for Hamotzi, use disposable tableware as a precaution, and keep the bread on special disposable plates which will be disposed of immediately after consuming your Lechem Mishneh. Then proceed with your meals as normal. For the crumbs that are left over on the plates where you had your bread, take these plates over to the toilet and shake off the crumbs and any

other leftover bread into the toilet and flush. You should do the same for any crumbs that may have fallen to the ground.

Option B (recommended): Use only egg matzah on Erev Pesach for your meals. Egg matzah is not considered usable for Ashkenazim on Pesach (except for people with health conditions), but is not considered Chametz, so it can be placed on your Pesach utensils. There is also no prohibition of eating egg matzah on Erev Pesach, at least up until the time when you may eat Chametz. You also avoid the anxiety and cleanup issues from Option A. According to Rav Moshe Feinstein, this is a perfectly acceptable option. This is also the minhag in the Korobkin home. I certainly recommend this option, especially if Option A will create nervousness or strife.

Regardless of whether you use Option A or B, we still have to address the second challenge, which is that after the end of the fourth halakhic hour of the day, which in Thornhill on April 12 is 10:31 am, one cannot eat Chametz or egg matzah. So what can be done? Firstly, we will be holding services earlier than normal on Shabbos morning, April 12, so as to allow everyone to get home in time to have TWO meals by 10:31 am. That is, you will have your morning Shabbos meal early (with either bread or egg matzah), you will bensch, and then take a short break where you should leave the room, go for a walk, or read a book for at least 15 minutes. You may then wash again, have a second meal with bread or egg matzah, and this will count as your Shalosh Seudos. Make sure that all your Chametz or egg matzah is fully consumed by 10:31 am. You should then make sure to recite the declaration of "kol chamira" before 11:47 am.

The only other consideration for the three Shabbos meals is that according to some poskim, you can only fulfill the mitzvah of Shalosh Seudos if you eat that third meal in the afternoon. To satisfy this opinion, the second meal you had in the morning does not suffice, and so you should eat something light in the afternoon, such as a piece of fish, egg, salad, fruit, or non-Gebruchtz Pesach confections, with the reminder that by this time you may have neither Chametz nor egg matzah. Make sure not to eat too much in the afternoon so that you will have a hearty appetite for the Seder.

Seder Preparations: We recommend that all the Seder preparations be completed before Shabbos, including the grinding of the horseradish and the checking of the lettuce for Marror, the making of the charoses, preparing the salt water, and all other cooking and meal preparations. One is not permitted to prepare for the Seder on Shabbos, even if that preparation does not involve melacha. Therefore, one must wait until Shabbos is over (8:24 pm), recite the words, "Baruch HaMavdil bein Kodesh l'Kodesh" ("Blessed is He who separates between holiness to holiness"), and then one may set the table, get the chairs, start warming the food, and any other preparations for the Seder.

Remember that in Maariv on Motzai Shabbos you will recite the standard Yom Tov davening but will include the paragraph of "Vatodienu" in the Amidah. You will also make Havdalah in the Kiddush that you make at the first Seder Saturday night, as is printed in the Haggadah.

May we merit to celebrate next year in Jerusalem!
